100% Payout as follows:

75% to 1st (Minimum \$200.00) / 15% to 2nd / 10% to 3rd.

RULES

1. Open registration begins at 5:00pm and ends at 6:30pm at the grandstand in the Pekin Park.
 2. Complete Entry forms and fees are required during registration.
 3. Idol contest starts at 6:30pm at the grandstand in the Pekin Park.
 4. No Age restrictions, however anyone 17 or younger MUST have parents Consent.
 5. All Contestants should have 2 songs picked out in case of a Tie. Tie breaker contestants will perform a second song, different from their first. The Winner will be picked based on audience response. PLEASE BRING YOUR OWN CD'S WITH MUSIC ONLY NO VOCALS. Songs are to be 4 Minutes or Less.
 6. Neither the EMT's DJ & Karaoke nor the Pekin Betterment Organization will be responsible for accidents.
 7. Contestants will be judged on Appearance, Vocal, Performance, and Audience reaction, so bring all your family and friends.
