

Grammy nominated band to perform Friday in Lanesville

New Life Christian Church of Lanesville will host "An Evening of Bluegrass" on June 18. The evening will feature "Cherryhomes" with special guest Relic. "Cherryholmes" is the 2005 IBMA Entertainer of the year and the group has also been nominated for four grammys.

Seating is limited to 450 and the event is expected to sell out.
