

Strong, Philips talk about Sept. 4 battle in Louisville

It's football season again in the Commonwealth, as University of Louisville head coach [Charlie Strong](#) met the media about a week before camp begins on Aug. 5.

Strong and Kentucky coach Joker Philips talked about the upcoming game between the Cardinals and Wildcats on Sept. 4 at Papa John's Cardinal Stadium.

The two head coaches had a brief press conference at the annual Governor's Cup gathering Wednesday afternoon at Lake Forest C.C.
