**IMPORTANT NOTICE:** A \$15 per child non-negotiable LATE registration fee will apply after the last sign-up date of February 16th. No late registrations will be accepted after March 7th.

Please be sure to bring a copy of your child's birth certificate to sign-ups for age verification.

There will be a skill evaluation in March for all children in the ROOKIE League for the sole purpose of helping to divide teams more evenly.

Each parent will be required to work a minimum of one time per child in the concession stand during the season. By all parents participating to support the BYL concession stand, the League benefits from increased profits, which in turn allows for the enhancement of the youth program.

The BYL continues to have its free gear and equipment exchange. Parents, please bring any outgrown, or no longer used, gear to sign-ups for donation (or to the ball park during the year). Likewise please feel free to take any donated gear that is available that your child may be able to use. Feel free to speak with/or contact a board member if you have any questions. Sign-up fees per family are \$40.00 for one child, \$30.00 for each additional child. Price includes game shirt and hat. For children chosen for All-Stars, additional fees will apply.
