She must be an active member of at least one worthwhile organization in the community and should be sponsored by a Clark County business and/or organization. There is a \$50.00 entry fee which should be paid by the sponsor.

Contestants will be judged on the basis of poise, personality, state presence, ability to converse, and overall impression. Prizes and awards will be given to all contestants as well as the category winners some of which include cash gifts..
