

Before the Indianapolis Colts took the field Sunday at Lucas Oil Stadium, a group of talented children competed in the NFL's Punt, Pass & Kick Team Championships. Among the competitors was 13 year-old Renee Sisloff of Floyds Knobs, Indiana.
