

Luke Hancock, who was voted Most Outstanding Player in the 2013 NCAA Final Four for the Louisville Cardinals, will host a basketball skills camp in Southern Indiana. Hancock's two-day camp will be held at Floyd Central.

The cost of the camp is \$100 and that includes both days.

The camp is for both boys and girls. There are two groups, fourth through seventh grades and eighth through 12th grades.

Hancock will be on hand to teach shooting technique, ball handling, one-on-one moves, elite passings skills, game strategy, competitive game situations, attack dribbles and defensive footwork.

In addition to personal instruction from Hancock, campers will receive a Luke Hancock Elite Skill Academy T-shirt; personal photograph opportunities and autographs from Hancock and other surprise lecturers.
