Walters, who had dreams of successfully playing on the PGA Tour before an accident left him paralyzed from the waist down, vowed never to give up playing golf. Through his golf show, he delivers a mix of trick shots and life lessons alongside his canine companion, Bucky.

Kentucky and Indiana PGA Professionals will then take participants through a series of golf stations, including inflatable golf targets Golf-Zilla and Golf-Gator. The clinic focuses on the fun and fitness elements of the game, along with its affordability and accessibility to all ages, abilities and backgrounds.
