

Maybe he only wanted a picture....

A Scottsburg man who allegedly pilfered a disposable camera from a local store is now in hot water in Scott Superior Court over what was also found in his pockets.

Russell W. Terry, 28, was taken into custody by Lt. Richey Barton on May 19 after he had purportedly taken the camera and left the store without paying for it.

In patting him down, Lt. Richey reported that he found pills that included Alprazolam, Diazepam, Endocet and Acetaminophen-Oxycodone in one of Terry's pockets.

Terry now faces two counts of possession of a controlled substance, both Class D felonies, and a count of public intoxication, a Class B misdemeanor.

On Thursday, May 20, Deputy Prosecutor Chris Owens filed a petition for detainer and/or greater than standard bond. The petition was based on records that showed Terry is on probation from an earlier criminal case through May 21, 2011. Judge Nicholas South increased Terry's bond from \$15,000 to \$30,000 corporate surety or 10% cash.

At Terry's initial appearance, Judge South set his trial for August 10 after receiving his not guilty plea. He was provided with the services of a public defender.
