Over 330 people from all over Scott County came and received a free hot meal and a grocery food voucher valued at \$20. Around 50 people received free medical care that included school sport physicals, colds, flu and other non-urgent needs. We appreciate Joel Nunley, M.D. who is also the pastor of City on a Hill Church and Sara Feltner, N.P, who provided free medical care services to so many families who just can’t afford the added medical expense.
