

?Scottsburg Warriors drop game against Madison Cubs 62-55

? The Warriors traveled to Madison on January 9 looking to rebound off a frustrating loss to Seymour.

Madison, at 2-6, hoped to play spoiler to Scottsburg's momentum. The two squads played each other close throughout the first half with Madison leading 33-29 at the break. There was hope to be had for the Warriors, however, as sophomore guard Mason Gregory began to find his shooting stroke that had left him for a few games.

The Cubs went on a run in the third quarter, outscoring Scottsburg 16 to 12. They took a 49- 41 lead into the fourth quarter, knowing that the Warriors have outscored their opponents in the final period nearly every time this season.
