

Warriors redeemed in first round of the sectional

Madison defeated Scottsburg by seven in their regular season matchup 62-55, and the Warriors felt that they should have won that game, and set out to prove it.

Defeating Madison would be no easy task, as the Cubs had the home floor, and the bragging rights.

It mattered not for Scottsburg as they came out of the gate on fire from down town, as A.J. Humes and Mason Gregory would drain several early threes. This would boost Scottsburg to a 10 point halftime lead that would grow in the second half.
