

## Clark County Taxes due on November 10

Janet Hurts, Clark County Treasurer wants to remind taxpayers that their annual tax payment is due on November 10. This payment is for tax year 2008-2009. It is the responsibility of the taxpayer to make sure that their taxes are paid by the due date to prevent a penalty being applied. A 5% penalty will be added to the tax bill when paid within 30 days after the due date and there are no other outstanding delinquent charges. An additional 5% penalty, a total of 10%, will be added to the tax bill when not paid within 30 days after the due date.

Payment options include:

**Mail:** Payment with coupons to the Clark County Treasurer, P.O. Box 1508, Jeffersonville, IN 47131. Enclose a self-addressed stamped envelope for return receipt. Payment is considered on time when postmarked by the US Post Office by the due date.

**In Person:** Treasurer is located in the Clark County Government Building, Rm. 125, Jeffersonville. Please bring entire statement when paying in person.

**Banks:** Mainsource Bank, New Washington and Your Community Bank will accept payments by cash or check with coupon/statement at all Clark and Floyd County locations.

**Credit Cards:** (Visa, Mastercard, Discover or American Express). All credit card payment will be processed through Point & Pay with a convenience fee of 2.95% of your total tax statement, min. \$2.
