

Clark County Drug Treatment Court celebrates 11th graduation, Alternative sentencing program to gradu

The Clark County Drug Treatment Court Program will host its eleventh graduation on Thursday, December 17 at 3:30 p.m.

Rev. Charles Harrison will be the keynote speaker.

The Clark Superior Court No. 2 operates one of only 25 adult drug courts in the state, certified by the Indiana Supreme Court. The court will honor seven graduates for their rehabilitative efforts over the last three years.

Since 2002, the program has provided services to 124 participants without a taxpayer funded budget.

The Drug Court program graduation will begin at 3:30 p.m. in Clark Superior Court No. 2. A reception will follow at 4:30 p.m. The public is invited to attend.
