

Lady Pirate named Subway Player of the Week

Charlestown Lady Pirate Justice Burdin named an IBCA/Subway Players of the Week in the first week of 2012-13 season, for their performances during the week of November 5-10.

Burdin, a 5' 11" sophomore wing, notched a double-double as Charlestown began its season with a 64-37 triumph over Southwestern (Hanover). Burdin tallied 21 points and 14 rebounds as the Pirates jumped to a big lead and captured the season-opening decision over the Rebels.
