The following is a summary of the No Parking restricted areas (both sides of the street) for Saturday, June 22:

*Monroe Street from State Road 62 to Market Street

The following is a summary of all Road Closures for Friday and Saturday, June 21 and 22:

*Main Street from Market Street to Walnut Street, Spring Street from Main Street to Thompson on Friday from 3 to 11 p.m.

*Main Street from Market to Walnut Street, Spring Street from Main Street to Thompson on Saturday from 8 a.m. to 11 p.m.

*Main Cross to Main Street, Main Street to Monroe Street, Monroe Street to State Road 3, State Road 3 to Main Street (northbound right hand lane) on Saturday from 8 to 9 a.m.
