As a reminder, alcoholic beverages, weapons of any kind, lude or disorderly conduct will not be permitted or tolerated in and around the event areas, including Greenway Park, Jonathan Jennings Carnival Rides area and the City Square.

The following is a summary of the NO PARKING restricted areas (both sides of the street) for Saturday, June 27th, 2009.

1. HIGH STREET from Walnut St. to Market St. 2. WALNUT STREET from High St. to Main St.
3. MAIN STREET from Walnut St. to Wood St. 4. SPRING STREET from Main St. to Thompson St.
5. MONROE STREET from Sr 62 to Market St.
