The meeting will be held on August 19 at 7:00 p.m., at the Community Learning Center. Representatives from the Foundation will discuss the grant criteria, which is as follows:

Opportunities that will provide more independence for women and expanding horizons for girls, including but not limited to: education, training, vocational skills, counseling, mentoring, and life skills programs that address the immediate needs of women and children.

Guidelines, application process, deadlines and reporting process will also be discussed. There will be an opportunity to ask questions. The goal is that by the end of the meeting, all potential applicants will have a strong understanding of the process. All grant applicants are strongly encouraged to attend this session and bring project or program ideas with you.

Grant applications for the grant cycle will be available at the public meeting and the WCCF office. The Washington County Community Foundation will begin accepting applications on August 20.
