Sign-up times and dates are as follows: September 18 from 3 to 4:30 pm; September 19 from 3 to 5 pm; September 20 from 3 to 4:30 pm; September 21 and 25 from 9 to 11 am; September 26 from 2:30 to 4:30 pm; and October 2 from 3 to 5 pm.

All sign-up opportunities will take place at the Parks and Recreation Office. This program is for students attending the Salem school district only. The cost is \$35.

All sign-up opportunities take place at the Parks and Recreation Office. The cost is \$35 and is open to Salem students only.
