The Summer Reading Program at the Salem Library begins on June 1 and they may begin signing up on June 1 or anytime after June 1. Summer Reading Program ends on July 13 and NO prizes will be awarded after July 13 (No Exceptions). You will need to come to the library to sign up and fill out your registration card, also to receive your reading logs and other summer programming information.

Theme "Dig into Reading" Birth to entering grade 1 must read or have read to them 40 books to complete the SRP. Grades 2 - 5 must read a total of 600 minutes to complete. They may read anything they would like including books, magazines or books on CD (DVD's and Video games do not count).

Theme for the Young Adult program is "Beneath the Surface" this program is for young adults entering grades 6 - 12. They must read 10 books to complete and they may read books, magazines or books on CD (easy readers do not count for this age group).
