

Wonder Valley Christian Camp to host soccer and martial arts camps

Campers can also try out a variety of firearms and archery equipment in a highly supervised setting. Participants in the Outdoor Sports Camp can earn their Hunter's Education card by passing the test at the end of the week. Horse Camp allows students to travel to Davis Ranch in Hardinsburg for some hands-on equestrian experience.

During the week, campers will also have a chance to enjoy the other amenities of Wonder Valley, including rock climbing, the Giant Swing, water slide, swimming, kayaking and other recreational activities. Time will also be spent in Bible classes and praise and worship.
