The bottom of the front door had been pried open and someone had entered the building.

The cash register had been taken with approximately \$256.00 inside of it.

They were then shown a video of a thin male with a thin beard attempting to open the cash register with a knife and screw driver.

The suspect was dressed in a black hoodie with stripes on it and a camouflage hat.

The suspect could be seen on the video retrieving bills from the register with the knife.

It also appeared that the male suspect was wearing a large ring on his left hand that appeared to be silver in color. The suspect then took the cash register and left the building
