? The Women's Giving Circle of the Washington County Community Foundation is pleased to announce they have closed out their historic first grant cycle and were able to award grants to three organizations.

The Washington County Prosecutor's office is the recipient of a \$4,000 grant to be used for a special victims fund. The fund will be used to provide counseling to victims of child molestation who do not qualify for Department of Family and Children assistance, Medicaid, or their insurance will not cover counseling.

Training materials and reference guides is the focus of a \$575 grant to Big Brothers Big Sisters of Washington County. The guides will be available to all participants (youth and adult) and parents of youth participants.

Hoosier Hills PACT has been awarded a \$1,325 grant for bathroom renovations at the domestic violence shelter. Renovations include painting, installing a new vanity with mirrors, new lights. A new bathtub with a handrail for client safety will also be installed.
